**NOTIFICATION OF DOCKET ENTRY**

This docket entry was made by the Clerk on Monday, October 24, 2016:

MINUTE entry before the Honorable Sharon Johnson Coleman: The Court finds that Plaintiff's objections [123] to the motion for attorney's fees are untimely. Plaintiff had multiple opportunities to file a written response and to respond orally to Defendant's motion for attorneys fees [99] but Plaintiff failed to respond. Plaintiff also failed to engage in discussions with Defendant pursuant to LR54.3. Plaintiff and Counsel for Plaintiff failed to appear before the Court on multiple occasions, including at the hearing on Defendant's written report itemizing its requested amount of attorney's fees. Plaintiff also failed to object to Defendant's written request for and itemized report detailing costs and attorney's fees [120, 121]. Accordingly, the Court finds that Defendant's request for attorney's fees in the amount of \$148,201.00 is reasonable. The Court infers from the motion for attorney's fees that Defendant seeks payment from Marshall Feature Recognition, LLC and not from its counsel. As a result of the conduct described in the motion for attorney's fees and Plaintiff's failure to cooperate with the Court, Plaintiff Marshall Feature Recognition, LLC is ordered to pay Defendant Wendy's International, Inc. \$148,201.00 for attorney's fees. This case was closed after the hearing on 10/21/2016, therefore the motion to withdraw [122] is stricken as moot. Mailed notice(rth, )
